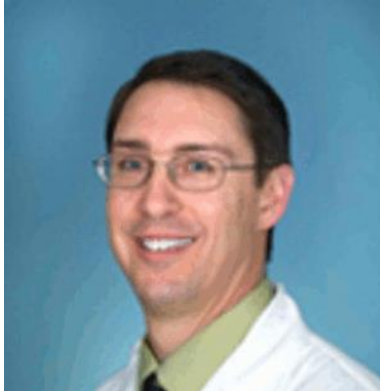




NATHAN CHASE, M.D.
